## Blizzard Bag Day 1

Using your camera, take window portraits. You can also shoot portraits outside, if you prefer. You should plan to shoot for a half hour. Make a new page on your site called “Blizzard Bags” and add them there. You’ll be able to delete this page later.

## Blizzard Bag Day 2

Download and install an image editing application to your computer. This must be a new app, and not an app that is already installed on your computer. This activity should take you a half hour.

- Make sure you download and install “open source” or free software. Search for “open source image editor” and browse for an app that sounds good.
  - If you install Gimp, you’ll need to install UFRAW to read RAW files.
- If you’d like to install Lightroom or Photoshop, download and install a free 30 day trial.
- Take a photo of the application in your Applications folder on your computer and add that photo to your website in the Blizzard Bags page you created.

## Blizzard Bag Day 3

Edit your best photos from day one in the open source image editor you installed on day 2. Add these photos to your Blizzard Bag page on your website. This should take you about a half hour.
