Welcome to Pickerington High School Central's Photography curriculum. The curriculum consists of 4 classes for art credit, as follows:

- Foundations in Photography
- Intermediate Photography, offered for college credit at CSCC and is a 4.75 class
- Advanced Photography A
- Advanced Photography B

Purchasing Film and Photo Paper

Students in Foundations in Photography must supply film and photo paper for the course. Both film and photo paper can be purchased at the school store at a greatly reduced price before school and during lunch periods. Students are free to purchase these supplies outside of school.

Students should plan to purchase at least 3 rolls of film and one pack of paper. If students expose their material, or use it up, they should plan to buy more. Paper from printers at home will not work in our darkroom.

If you want to buy your film/paper outside of school

The film we use as follows:

- 400 ISO black and white film (some stores carry black and white film that uses C41 processing which can not be used in our lab, so look carefully for "C41 Process")

The photo paper we use as follows:

- Polycontrast III resin coated black and white photo paper
- As mentioned, photo paper is available at the school store before school and during lunch periods.
